JR STAFF SERVICE AGREEMENT

I, (name) _____, have volunteered to work at the Cub Scout Day Camp for four days (Tuesday through Friday), from either 7:30am – 2:00pm for AM Session or 2:30-9:00pm for PM Session.

JR STAFF JOB DESCRIPTION:

1. Be responsible to Jr Staff Leader, Registration Director and Camp Director.
2. Jr Staff should be present at camp set-up on the Monday prior to their camp week.
3. Each staff member is required to be at camp for their working session.
4. Check in at Registration table each day by 7:30AM or 2:30PM.
5. Collect daily supplies from supply room, and return unused supplies to room at the end of each day. Assist with storage of supplies when needed.
6. Each staff member is responsible for the "set-up" of their specific activity area and should be ready for the boy's arrival at 8:00 each morning or 3:00 each afternoon.
7. In cooperation with the Den Leaders and Session Leaders, plan and carry out the program outlined for your area by the Program Director.
8. Organize the boys as soon as they arrive in your area and get them started on the activities as quickly as possible.
9. Demonstrate or show the boys a sample of the activity and assist as needed.
10. Keep the boys in your activity area until the end of the session. Do not let the boys wander off in the middle of the session.

I understand that:

- I am expected to follow the same rules and guidelines as adult staff.
- My purpose at camp for the week is to assist the adult staff in the position I am assigned.
- I am a role model for younger scouts and will always act accordingly.
- Should there become an issue with my participation; I understand that I will first be counseled by my Jr Staff Leader and if an issue persists, I may be removed from the Jr Staff program and no Service Credit Hours will be given.

I agree to abide by the above job descriptions, guidelines, and the following camp regulations:

- *Camp T-shirts must be worn every day.
- *Walking shorts may be worn - no very short shorts.
- *Be courteous. patient. and helpful to all at camp.
- *Avoid abusive language, swearing, or aggressive behavior.
- *Smoking or chewing tobacco in front of scouts is not allowed.
- *No gum chewing allowed at camp -
- *Wear sensible shoes - no open toe shoes.
- *Bring any problems to the Key Staff (Red Shirts)
